



OPERATING GUIDELINE

AMBASSADOR AWARD

I. OBJECTIVE

To define the requirements for receiving “Ambassador Award” status in recognition of service within the Mid-Atlantic Region Society of Quality Assurance (**MARSQA**).

II. PROCEDURE

This award will be presented to any member of MARSQA who has performed notable and continued service within the organization.

Nominations for the Ambassador Award are to come from the current MARSQA members during the calendar year for which the award will be presented. Self-nominations will not be accepted.

The recipient will receive the award at the final membership meeting of the year, and there does not have to be a recipient each calendar year.

Nominations are to be forwarded to the Vice President no later than August 15th.

III. CRITERIA FOR RECEIVING “AMBASSADOR AWARD”

In order to be eligible for the award, the nominee must meet the following criteria:

- Must have been a member of MARSQA for at least five (5) years
- Must have served as an Officer, Director, or served as a Committee member within this five year period
- Must have made a significant contribution(s) to MARSQA that resulted in positive growth and development of the organization, as determined by the Board of Directors.

IV. RECORDS

Records of all recipients receiving the Ambassador Award will be maintained by the Historical Committee.
